Walters Center 2023 Show

Washington County artists from both Washington County Open Studios and the Village Gallery of Arts have been offered space next year in a joint exhibition at the **Walters**Center April 4 – May 26, 2023. Chris Goldthorpe and I have met with the curator and will forward on further details. You are eligible to apply if you are a member of Village Gallery and you live in Washington County.

Due to the shared space we will only have the opportunity to display **one piece per artist**. Village Gallery artists will be able to display around 20-25 two dimensional pieces and there is a small amount of space for three dimensional pieces. Artwork will be accepted on a **first come-first served basis**. If you have already responded to this opportunity by virtue of being part of Washington County Open Studios there is no need to apply a second time.

The space at the Walters Center is split between the upstairs gallery and the basement gallery, The curator will decide the location of the pieces. All 2-dimension pieces must have a hanging wire (no saw tooth hangers). The curator reserves the right to reject any pieces of artwork but this is rare. Examples of reasons why a piece could be rejected include that it is not appropriate for all ages or it was a three dimensional piece with sharp edges and was considered to be a safety issue. There is a **30% commission on any sales**.
