Call to Artists—Art Dollars for Scholars 2024

OPEN SHOW AT THE VILLAGE GALLERY OF ARTS

The Village Gallery of Arts invites you to participate in our community show! Net proceeds from our entry fees will be used to fund scholarships for graduating high school seniors who are continuing their art education.

GUIDELINES & ENTRY INFORMATION

- 3 Divisions: VGA Members Community – Adults Community – Youths (18 & under)
- \$15 per entry for Adults VGA will provide 10"X10" wood panel; limit 2 entries per artist
- One free 6"X6" canvas to those entrants 18 & under (option to purchase 10"X10" wood panel)
- Panels may be used as is or altered in any way the artist sees fit, but must fit within the 10"X10" or 6"x6" frame of the substrate. May not stick out further than 4" from the wall. No frames may be added.
- 10"X10" wood substrates may serve as a base for a free-standing 3D entry. The piece must sit on the panel & not extend over the edges, nor be taller than 10".
- Artists must use the substrates provided by the Village Gallery. Any media is acceptable and the work must be *completely dry* when submitted. Any ceramic entries must be fired.
- 10"×10" panels must be wired (taut) 3" from the top with D-rings. 6"×6" canvases need no wires. Please mark ↑on the back to indicate top.
- All work must be original and entirely the work of the exhibiting artist.
- All artists must submit a *completed* entry form with their work. Any updates will be communicated via email.
- All artwork must be priced for sale. VGA advertises affordable local art. Price your work accordingly. VGA will retain a 30% commission on all sales. Buyer receives sold art at time of purchase, beginning at May 11 reception. (We ask that prior sales remain on display until May 11)

April 30 - Deliver completed art with label & entry form to VGA
May 6 Gallery team hangs show
May 7 Show opens
May 11 Art Chat/Reception 3-5pm (Saturday)
June 2 Show ends
June 4 - 30 Pick up unsold work

Note: any work remaining at VGA after June 30th becomes the property of VGA and may be used as a donation or recycled for educational purposes.
